

COURSE SYLLABUS ENGLISH LITERATURE STUDIES

Course Title: Research Method

Total Credit: 2

Course Description

This course is aimed to provide the course participants opportunity to broaden their perspectives about current trends in the methods of language and literary studies so that they are able to make sense research-related works in language and literature. Finally, they are expected to carry out and report their own studies. The course participants will try to understand basic concepts in research, try to make sense research reports they encounter in their daily life, and write their own research proposal. During the course they will be divided into groups and assigned certain topics to read. Then they will share what they read in a classroom discussion. They will also have to read and improve their own understanding through extensive information searching in the library.

Course Objective

At the end of the course, the course participants are expected to be able to:

- 1) Make sense research reports like coursework, dissertation, journals and the like.
- 2) Write a research proposal based on their own interest.

Course Assessment

The course participants will be based on Mid test, Final Test, assignment, group presentation, critical reading, and research proposal.
